

LOWDEN FAMILY

OF ANDOVER

John Lowden , born about 1721, married Mary Chandler, of Roxbury, daughter of Zachary (4)-(Wm. (3) (2) (1),- who was born March 20,1724. She became demented and wandered all over the country asking for "Cheese and vinegar." She came to Andover and stayed a while, and so he got tired and was allowed to get a separation, and about 1775, married a young wife, Elizabeth--.

When Mary went back to Roxbury, the second wife took her in and cared for her until she died, Dec. 10, 1792. The second wife died Feb. 11, 1793, at 44. three months later, John Lowden died April 8, 1799.
