Founded and operated by The Church of Jesus Christ of Latter Day Saints, FamilySearch is the world's largest repository of genealogical records, and also offers library services and software to facilitate genealogical research. Healthy & Allergen-Free Baking Workshop Tuesday, June 6 at 7pm in Memorial Hall



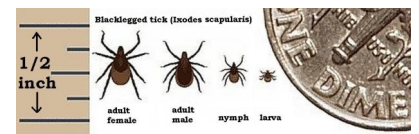

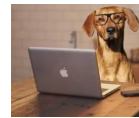
