




**Honor Girl by Maggie Thrash**


**Symphony for the City of the Dead: Dimitri Shostakovich and the Siege of Leningrad**


**Black Lives Matter**

Learn more about the shootings that touched off passionate protests, the work of activists to bring about a more just legal system, and the tensions in US society that these events have brought to light.




**Everything is Teeth**


**Marooned in the Arctic: The True Story of Ada Blackjack, the "Female Robinson Crusoe"**


**Bubonic Panic: When Plague Invaded America**


**This Land is Our Land: A History of American**


**The Imitation Game: Alan Turing Decoded**


**Trinity: A Graphic History of the First Atomic Bomb**

An unflinching look at the far-reaching political, environmental, and psychological effects of the atomic bomb. In pictures.





Did you know that the library lends ukuleles? Well, it does. And here's the book that can teach you how to become awesome at it.




**Same But Different: Teen Life on the Autism Express**
