Attention! In Order to Qualify for Judging:

- You must be a student in grades 6-12 and live in or attend school in Andover.
- Entries must be original work.
- Limit of three (3) poems submitted per person.
- Every entry must have a title. The title must be on the entry form and on the page with your poem.
- Each poem must be emailed to klynn@mhl.org or attached to a separate entry form.
- Do **NOT** place your name anywhere on the page your poem is written on.
- **Deadline for submission: 9pm, Monday, March 10, 2008.**
- Entry forms that are not filled out clearly and correctly may not be judged.
