DANIEL COLBY and Hannah Gray were married in Andover, Sept. 2, 1730, by the Rev. Jn. Barnard. They had:-

Hannah (2) b. in Andover, Oct. 22, 1735; m. Solomon Abbott of Andover, May 3, 1756.

Sarah (2), b. in Andover, Dec. 26, 1742.

Daniel (2), b. " " , Oct. 20, 1738.

Daniel Colby, then of Dracut, made a will in 1783. He left to his wife, Hannah, the use of all the house goods during her lifetime and mentioned a bond he had provided for her maintenance. To his daughter, Hannah, wife of Solomon Abbott, £ 3 added to her dower. To his grandchildren, 5 Spanish milled dollars, each. To his grandchildren, Solomon Abbott and John Abbott, all the estate remaining after the grandmother's death.

Solomon Abbott, Jr., was exexutor.
